

2021 Shanghai Government Scholarship

for International Students of Fudan University

Eligibility

1. Applicants should be non-Chinese citizens and in good health.
2. Applicants for master programs should have obtained a bachelor's degree and be under the age of 35; applicants for doctoral programs should have obtained a master's degree and be under the age of 40;
3. Applicants should not be holding any other scholarship provided by Chinese government.

Coverage

Exemption from tuition fee, providing free on-campus accommodation, Comprehensive Medical Insurance

Living stipend (Master student: 3000RMB/month, Doctoral student: 3500RMB/month).

Application Period

From December 10, 2020 to March 19, 2021

How to Apply

Step One:

Visit <http://study.edu.sh.gov.cn/apply/> to complete the application online. Print and sign the application form.

Step Two:

Visit <http://admission.iso.fudan.edu.cn> to complete the application. Please choose "Self-support" as the "fund source". When filling in the application form, choose the option of "Shanghai Government Scholarship" and upload the scholarship application form.

● Applicants who apply for the scholarships have to upload documents below.

(1) *Completely filled Foreigner Physical Examination Form*

The form can be downloaded from DOCUMENTS at <http://iso.fudan.edu.cn>, and should be filled out in Chinese or English, the report is valid for six months.

Applicants currently residing in China may submit Residence Permit or Foreign Permanent Resident ID Card in substitute for Foreigner Physical Examination Form.

(2) *Certificate of No Criminal Record* in Chinese or English

Result Check

The applicant may check the result by visiting the column "Notices" on ISO website (<http://iso.fudn.edu.cn>).

Notes

1. New scholarship students are required to register at Fudan University on the date specified on admission notice. Students who arrive late without approval in advance will have their Scholarship automatically cancelled. Students who have kept the admission but postponed their registration to the following academic year will have their scholarship cancelled.
2. New scholarship students must participate in annual evaluation. Students who fail to meet the requirements will have their scholarship cancelled.
3. New scholarship students are not be allowed to change the major or study period.
